Inpatient Rehabilitation at Gundersen helps patients regain as much function and independence as possible after a stroke, brain injury, spinal cord injury, amputation, surgery or other disabling conditions. When selecting an inpatient rehab program it's useful to look at outcome measures like these to judge the effectiveness of the program.

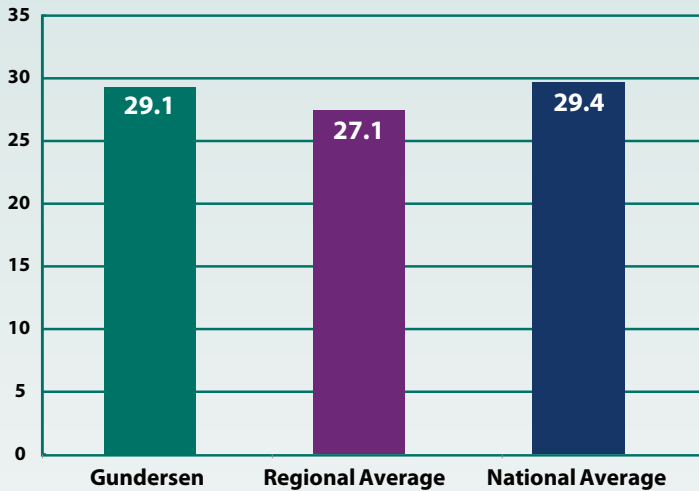
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Functional Independence Measurement (FIM)

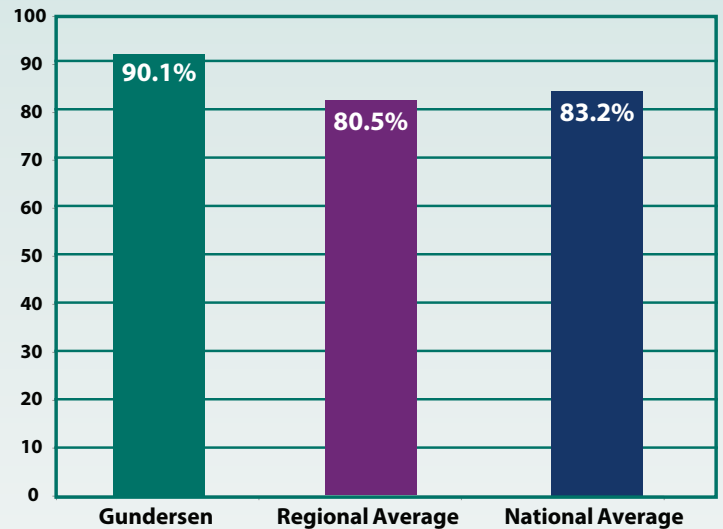
FIM is a nationally recognized measure of a patient’s functional abilities in areas such as eating, grooming, toileting, transfers, mobility, communication and cognitive skills.

(higher # is better)

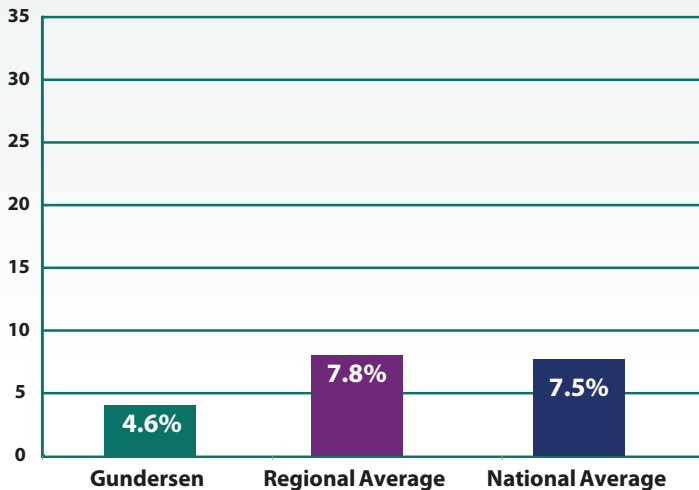


* Functional improvement from admission to discharge based on FIM point value system
