

Medical Student instructions for reviewing films while on the Emergency Medicine rotation.

If one of your patients has Imaging performed, when the patient returns from Radiology do the following to learn about this imaging:

- **From 8-5 call x 52213-(Radiology file room assistants).** It is critical that you identify yourself as a “medical student” as the assistants are aware to help you through this process!
- Tell them you are the medical student and would like to review a film on a patient. The assistant will tract down a Radiologist to review the film with you.
- From **5PM to 12AM**-call the operator (0) and ask to page the Radiologist on call-he/she will let you know when to come by to review the case – first floor near TEC
- If, for whatever reason, this process is not working for you, feel free to **call Dr Nigogosyan (C 608-385-9876).**

The large majority of **Radiologists are located on the first floor of the hospital (walk down the hallway from CT and MR through the double doors-the office suite is 20ft past the doors on the right).**
