2. Parent concerns
3. Nurse concerns
4. Current meds review
5. Vital signs with ranges
6. I&O's
7. Weight if pertinent
8. Focused examination
9. New or pending labs
10. Assessment
11. Recommendation

FYI – definition of oliguria

- Infant $<1\text{ml/kg/h}$
- Child $<0.5\text{mg/kg/h}$
- Older $<300\text{ ml/m}^2/\text{d}$
